Wagner Corp Shipping Stem 2022/23 Season at Non-Exempt Port Terminal: Pinkenba

1. 2022/23 SEASON SHIPPING STEM AT NON-EXEMPT PORT TERMINALS: MACKAY, GLADSTONE AND PORTLAND

Wagner Corporation Pty Ltd (**Wagner Corp**) will open its Shipping Stem for Short Term Capacity at Pinkenba at 10am AEST on 15th July 2022 for the Shipping Period 25 July – 30 September 2023. At the opening of the 2022/23 Stem, Customers will be able to place nomination requests for Short Term Capacity at Pinkenba in accordance with the Port Protocols for Non-Exempt Ports.

Elevation Capacity obtained through this process will be subject to signing and returning a Wagner Corp Bulk Wheat and Bulk Non-Wheat Port Terminal Services Agreement for 2022/23 at least 5 business days prior to submitting nomination applications. Please note that the vessel nomination booking fee for 2022/23 accepted nominations will increase to \$9.51 per metric tonne and all other port terminal fees will increase at a rate of 7.1%. Customers should note that they are booking 'Wheat' elevation capacity and other commodities will be accepted by negotiation only. The Wagner Corp Bulk Wheat and Bulk Non-Wheat Port Terminal Services Agreement for 2022/23 will be released shortly.

The below table outlines Elevation Periods and availability of Elevation Capacity for nomination. Please note the Elevation Capacity is presented in half months.
